Responsible consumption and production is about doing more and better with less. It is also about decoupling economic growth from environmental degradation, increasing resource efficiency and promoting sustainable lifestyles.

The world's energy and agriculture systems must be transformed to cope with growing demand to become more inclusive, secure and sustainable. The transformation pathways of the two systems are deeply entwined: agri-food systems consume about 30% of the world's energy, and a third of agri-food systems' emissions of greenhouse gases stem from energy use.

Camp's participants will have the opportunity to visit outstanding companies operating in the field of energy and agriculture that made sustainability their driver of innovation and growth and seeing it applied to operational processes and aimed at bringing value and pursuing excellence.

Furthermore, you will have the opportunity to experience the highest levels of sustainability applied to sport, in particular sailing as it represents an ideal place for training and experimentation, an environment where it is possible to embrace values and reproduce fundamental dynamics such as sustainable strategies, problem solving, team working and leadership.
